- Hosted multiple virtual parent events to keep parents involved



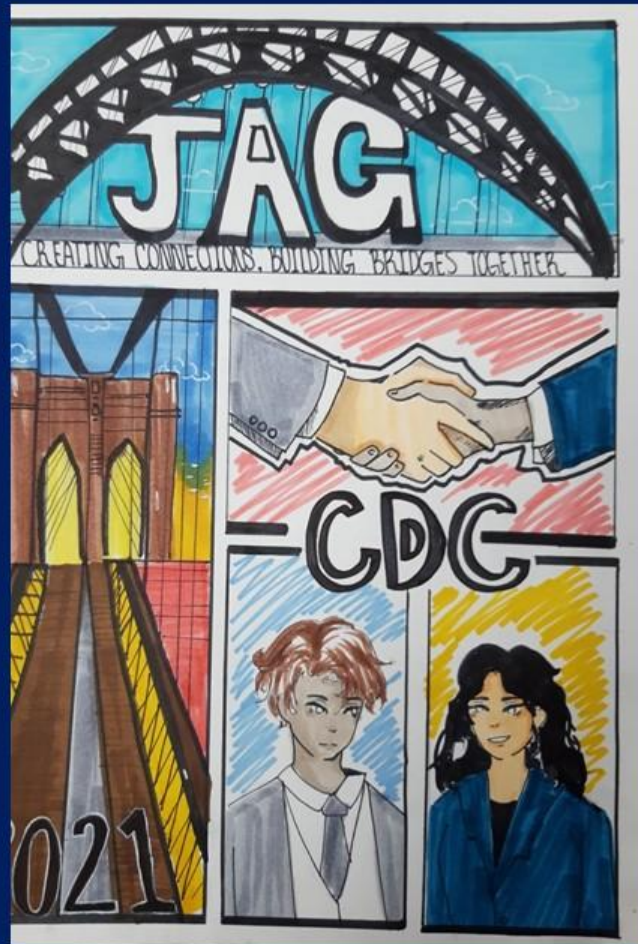

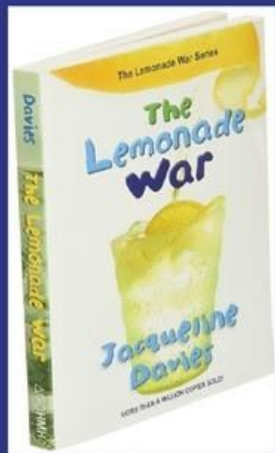
