






Written document that outlines emergency procedures, the chain of command, communication process, etc.

Organize & Equip


- Safety is everybody's job, but...
- Select members of:
 - Security Department
 - Communication Department
 - Student Information Management teams
 - Incident Command Teams



Training

- Every employee basic emergency procedures
 - In-person training at the start of each year
 - On-line Moodle course each year
- Incident Command System
 - FEMA Independent Study courses
 - Site specific training
- Parent/student reunification procedures
- Security in-service training

How we train staff to be prepared for an active shooter



Training Topics-Safety Related

In addition to Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) training, we conduct:

- Drug/Alcohol Awareness
- Mental Health Protocols
- Risk Assessment Protocols
- Threat Assessment Protocols
- Trauma Informed Practices
- Suicide Prevention Training

Exercise

- At a minimum, every school must conduct:
 - Evacuation drills once a month
 - Three lockdown drills per year
 - Two shelter-in-place drills per year

- In addition, we also do:
 - Tabletop exercises for administrators
 - Reunification exercises for SIMAR team


Evaluate / Improve

- Debrief of exercises
- Incorporate lessons learned into plans
- Quarterly meetings with ERP Consortium to share best practices
- Member of Arizona Department of Education Safety Advisory Council

Response

- Initiate protocols
 - -Get Out
 - Evacuation (on-site / off-site)
 - -Stay In
 - Lockdown
 - Modified Lockdown
 - Shelter In Place

HOW IT ALL SHOULD WORK



Emergency Communications

- Automated calling system
 - Voice
 - Text
 - Email
- Pulls in data from Synergy
 - Please ensure your information is up-todate at your school
- Speed of information / verification

Reunification

- Process to reunite students and parents after an emergency
- We use our high schools as reunification centers
- Parents notified of which high school at the time of the event


